

**1. Your Address**

Please enter your current address e.g. where you are resident.

**2. About you**

This form tells the Electoral Registration Officer that you want to vote by post. **This form is a legal document, so complete with care, as your vote may depend on it.** Each elector must apply on a separate form. An application form showing more than one elector's name will be rejected.

**3. Postal vote for how long?**

Please indicate the length of time you wish your postal vote for.

**4. Postal vote for which elections?**

Please tick the appropriate box.

**5. Address for ballot paper**

Tick the box provided if you wish your ballot papers to be issued to the address in Part 1. If you wish ballot papers to be issued to another address please supply the address and the reason for using this address. **Applicants should note that Ballot Papers are not issued on receipt of application but as part of the election process.**

**6. Your date of birth**

Supply your date of birth in format indicated.

**7. Your Signature**

Each person has to sign his/her own form.

**If you are unable to provide a signature, or you are unable to sign in a consistent or distinctive way because of any disability, or you are unable to read or write, the registration officer, in these circumstances, may grant you an exemption, which will mean you will not be required to provide a signature. If you wish to apply for an exemption please contact my office on FREEPHONE 0800 980 0471 (East Dumbartonshire).**

Your personal identifiers (signature and date of birth) will be stored securely. Each time you vote by post, your signature and date of birth provided on the postal voting statement may be checked by the Returning Officer against these identifiers, to ensure your postal vote remains secure.

You will need to make a new application if your circumstances change at all i.e. if your address or your name changes.

**Please note that if you are granted a postal vote, you are not allowed to vote at the polling station.**
